<p>Doc 2 – President negotiates treaties, Senate ratifies treaties</p> <p>Balance between executive and legislative branches</p>	<p>Doc 4 – Senate rejects Treaty of Versailles</p> <p>Outside info – Rejected because we were isolated and wanted to avoid war</p>
<p>Doc 1 – Impeachment (explain process)</p> <p>Legislative branch checks the Executive branch</p>	<p>Outside info – Impeachment of Clinton, charged with perjury and obstruction of justice</p>
<p>Doc 7 – Power of Congress to declare war</p>	<p>Doc 7 – President FDR asked Congress to</p>

Checks and Balances Function	Specific Example of Usage
<p>Doc 7 - Congress has the power to declare war</p> <p>Legislative is checking the executive branch</p>	<p>Outside info – Brings us into WW2, Last declared war</p> <p>Doc 7 – FDR asking Congress to declare war on Japan</p>
<p>Doc 1 – Impeachment (define) explain impeachment process</p> <p>Legislative branch checks the executive branch</p>	<p>Outside info – Clinton was impeached, charged with perjury and obstruction of justice</p>

<p>Doc 6 – Judicial review (define)</p> <p>Judicial branch is checking the legislative branch</p>	<p>Doc 5 – FDR court packing</p> <p>Outside info – Supreme court had been ruling FDR’s programs unconstitutional, FDR wanted to fill court with people who would support him</p>
<p>Doc 2 – Senate ratifies treaties</p> <p>Legislative check on the executive branch</p>	<p>Doc 4 – Senate failed to ratify Treaty of Versailles</p> <p>Outside info – Rejected the Treaty because we were isolated, and wanted to avoid war</p>
